



PRIVACY POLICY

Limpet Technology Limited (“Limpet”) is committed to responsible management of personal information in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (as amended) (the “DPA”). Please read our Privacy Policy to understand how Limpet collects, stores and uses your personal information.

1. Collection of Personal Information

Limpet may collect and process information about you that it receives from you: (i) when you fill in forms on the website that require you to provide your name, address and email address; (ii) when you contact Limpet, Limpet may keep a record of the correspondence; and (iii) through the use of cookies (see below). When you use this website, you consent to Limpet’s use of your information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

2. IP Addresses and Cookies

Limpet may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration purposes. This is statistical data about the users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.

For the same reason, Limpet may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help Limpet to improve the website and to deliver a better and more personalised service. You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of the website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, Limpet’s system will issue cookies when you log on to the website.

3. Storage of Personal Information

Limpet will keep your personal information for as long as it needs it to provide Limpet’s products and/or services to you. Limpet will try to keep personal information that it holds about you up to date, but if you think that Limpet is holding information which is inaccurate or you are otherwise unhappy about Limpet’s use of your personal information, then please tell us by sending an email to feedback@limpettechnology.com.

The personal information that Limpet collects from you may be transferred to and stored at a destination outside the European Economic Area (“EEA”) and it may be processed outside the EEA by the staff of Limpet’s suppliers. As you will appreciate, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although Limpet will endeavour to protect your personal information, Limpet cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to the website. Any transmission is at your own risk.

4. Use of Personal Information

Limpet will not sell the personal information that it collects from you. Limpet uses the personal information which it collects from you to help it provide products and/or services to you.

In the following circumstances, Limpet may need to share your personal data with other parties: (i) where Limpet has retained other companies or individuals to carry out certain services for it; (ii) where a related or associated company requires the information; (iii) in the event that Limpet or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party and Limpet's customer information is transferred as an asset; or (iv) where Limpet is required by law to release or disclose customer information.

5. Access

If you apply to Limpet in writing, you are entitled under the DPA to a copy of the personal information that Limpet holds about you. Limpet may make a small charge for dealing with any such request.

6. Changes to Privacy Policy

Limpet may change this Privacy Policy from time to time. Limpet will post a notification on the website if it has made significant changes to the policy.
